Site Info

Whatever stations are ACTUALLY ON-SITE at 1800z (2:00 PM, Saturday) will be counted in the category, ie. 3A, 6A. etc. A station may set up and operate later, but once a contact is made as, ie. 4A OH, it must remain that for the rest of the contest.

We will have two (2) generators operating plus 1 spare 5 KW generator this year. The stations will be widely separated to reduce any interference thus, there will be a generator in each of the two station set-up areas. If you are setting up a station, bring at least 100 ft. of extension cords, in as large a gauge (at least 14ga or larger) as you can, and a multi-tap outlet as well. This will ensure that you can get a connection to a generator with minimal voltage drop over a long distance.

Food

This year, NOARS will provide water for participants, 5 or 6 cases with 24 bottles per case.

Bring your own cooler, with water, soft drinks, snacks, food, etc.
