Thanks to Tedd, KB8NW, the Ohio/Penn PacketCluster Network, Alfred, DL1FL, and Bill, K5FUV, for the following DX information.

**SOMALIA.** Robin, WA6CDR, is with CBS and active as T55C. He plans to operate mostly CW and will be on whenever duties allow. He will have to QRT suddenly on occasion, as work takes priority. Robin plans to stay until the company leaves the area and will QSL after he returns stateside. Cards go to his home call.

**CAMBODIA.** Sanyi, HA7VK, has been signing XU7VK since early December. Check 14014 and 14185 kHz between 1900 to 0230z. QSL via HA0HW. John, PA3BTQ, is in Phnom Penh until the end of January and has been issued the call sign XU6TQ. Check for his CW on 14050 and 21050 kHz, and for SSB on 14315 and 21315 kHz. He may be on OSCAR 13 Mode B from time to time. QSL via PA0EQ. XU3UN has been worked from the eastern US with good signals on 80 meters SSB. He was on 3793 and listened on 3791, 3775 and then from 3770 to 3780 between 1200 and 1300z.

**MONGOLIA.** Several JT's, including JT1V, have been active on 80 meters at east coast sunrise.

**TONGA.** A35CT should be active for the next 2 to 3 years. Check 14219 kHz around 0530z.

**TAIWAN.** Check 80 meters for BV2A, BV2DJ and BV7JA, specifically 3500 through 3510 kHz from 1030 to 1430z.

**SPECIAL EVENT STATION.** VI5VIA will be active between January 29 and February 1 to mark the closing of the Adelaide Coastal Radio Station VIA, on January 31, 1993. VK5WC, VK5ZRH, and the South Coast Amateur Club, will operate on all HF bands and some VHF/UHF. VIA was commissioned in Adelaide on October 12, 1912. A special QSL card will be made available.

**SLOVAKIA.** DL1FL says after January 1, stations in Slovakia will use the prefix OM. Stations in the Czech Republic will continue to use OK and OL.

**BARBADOS.** Glenn, VE3ICR, will be active through February 6 as 8P9DX, a call sign he has held since 1987. He plans a full tilt effort in the CQ World Wide 160 CW Contest.

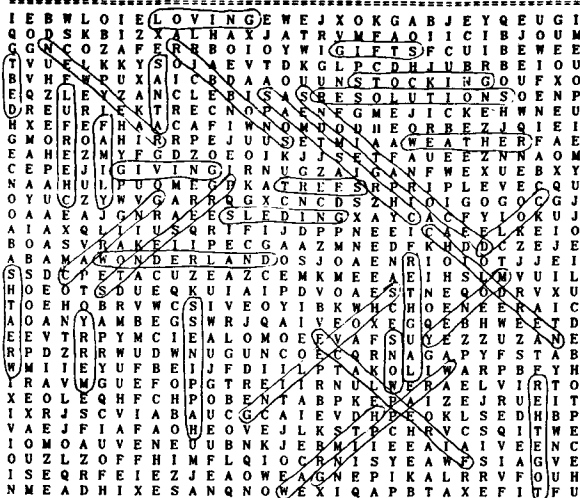

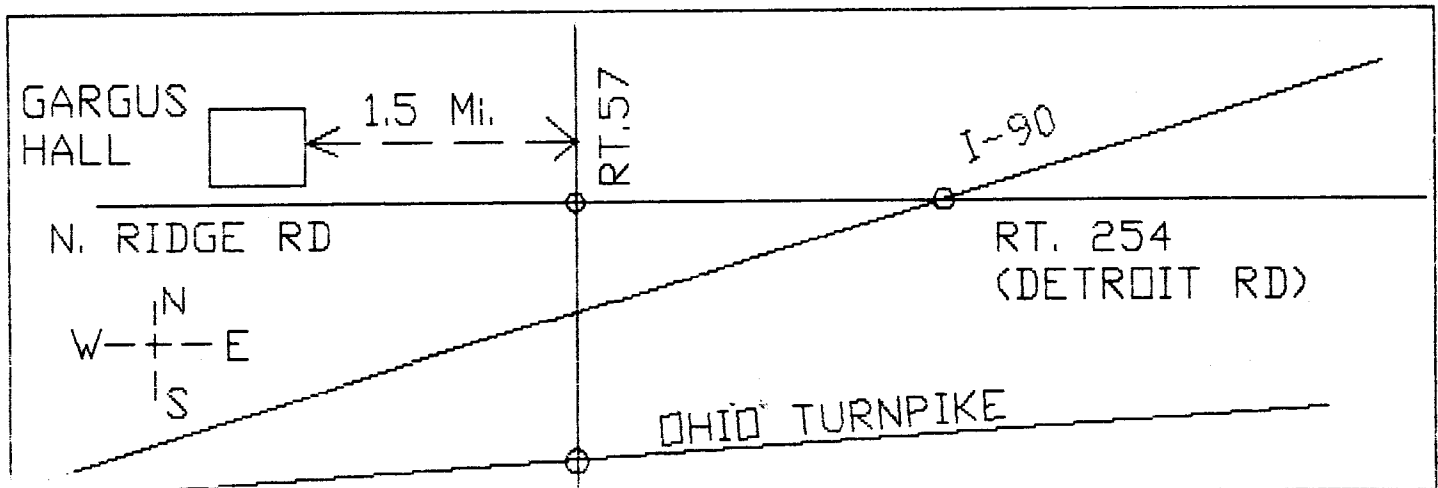
