Work continues on the website. New things are being added daily. And you can help. Here's how. If you want to contribute there's a few things you need to know. The individual page is based on a uniform width of 750 pixels. This makes it best viewable in 800x600 resolution. I use Microsoft Front page 2003™ for editing and designing the pages and set the page up as a chart with the charts width set accordingly. Although any good page authoring program will work. Special attention should be made to use compatible scripting that will work on all (most) browsers. Some of the stuff that works on Microsoft Internet Explorer™ may not work on FIREFOX™ (Mozilla) or AOL's browsers. So the keyword here is "keep it simple"! You will notice we don't publish email addresses on the site we use links so as to keep the spammers at bay. So if you include an email reference it will be masked EG:

webmaster2005@noars.net which will forward mail to my personal mail address.

The site has been moved to a new hosting provider who makes it easier for me to update the site. So send me your creations or ideas. All will be considered and used if possible.
