- 3B8, MAURITIUS (AF-Ø49) Luc, I3LDP, will be active from here between June 29th and July 11th. The callsign was not provided. Activity will be on the HF bands and 6 meters using CW and SSB. His equipment will be an Icom IC-7ØØØ, a vertical for 4Ø-1Øm and a vertical dipole for 6m. Grid Loc. is LG89vt. QSL via his home callsign. ADDED NOTE: Luc plans to look for a good location for an EME operation next year (2Ø1Ø).
- PA123, NETHERLANDS (Special Event) Members from the Dutch R31 M/N Limburg will be active as PA123OLS from St. Sebastianus, Neer, between June 29th and July 12th.
