- A7, QATAR Members of the Lufthansa Amateur Radio Club (LARC) in cooper- ation with the Qatar Amateur Radio Society (QARS A71A) will be active from here between November 27th and December 3th. Activity will be on all bands using CW, SSB and the Digi modes.

- EA8, CANARY ISLANDS Frank, DH5JG, will be active as EA8/DH5JG from Lanzarote, Canary Islands (AF-004, DIE S007), between November 22nd and December 3rd. Activity will be mostly CW on 80-10 meters, with an emphasis on the 30/17/12 meter bands. Operations will also include an entry in the CQWW DX CW Contest (November 27-28th). QSL via bureau to his home callsign.
- IOTA NEWS SA-057. Members of the Uruguay DX Group and Centro Radioaficionados Montevideo will be active as CW3TD from Timoteo Dominguez Island between December 2-6th. Activity will be on 160-2 meters with an emphasis on the Digital modes. They plan to have 15 operators and four stations on the air.
