## JARL: Please Keep 7.Ø3Ø MHz Clear for Disaster Communications

The Japan Amateur Radio League (JARL) is asking amateurs worldwide to keep 7.Ø3Ø MHz and surrounding frequencies clear for disaster communications in the aftermath of the earthquake and tsunami that struck northeastern Japan a week ago today.

In a statement on its website, JARL says its headquarters station, JA1RL, is maintaining contact with stations in the affected area to help with disaster relief efforts. It says the operation is mainly on 7.030 MHz and primarily between 2100 and 1100 UTC daily, but is asking hams to keep 7.030 clear around the clock until further notice.
