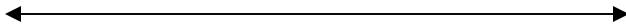

Time to think about Field Day, make a note to bring wool socks, who remembers the recent year we had frost Sunday morning? That warm breakfast was a very welcome feeling!

Well, this last meeting was an interesting one for the folks wondering about field day and who worked that station on one of the other bands, Alex helped Carl put on a demo of a logging program that allows a central database holding the answers to who worked who, where and when - I remember peeling back log sheets for many years and when we all sat close together you could look at the 10-75 mtr log book to see if you should send them up to another band before you say 73 old man good luck! So I hope this means we can have our stations on till the 2 O'clock bell rings and there will be goodies left at the picnic table because everyone is going to squeak out 2 more tries on that distant one, join us and try this new logging idea.

The repeater linking committee reports progress, just before the March meeting many components came into the hands of the members who volunteered to drill, measure, wire, solder, test pieces needed to fill in the spaces to get our repeaters linked together, crossband linking will be easy on the NOARS repeater system, this feature has been on 5.15 about 10 years and sporadically on 444.80, some tower work was done at Elyria and more will be needed as repair work once the weather gets past the frosty mornings to get the performance back on UHF regarding the antenna problems we experienced this past winter. Bill K8IC has been taking notes on the repeaters and after the March meeting guided Clark N8PZD into some IF circuit boards and a big change was discovered to help the 5.15 repeater; it has been back only a couple days. So if you like the results, thank Bill for making this happen. Bill K8IC has the GE spare parts from Clark N8PZD's cave of junk which had a few NOARS items.

- **2012 DX TRAVELS/OPERATING TOUR** ~Jeff, N6GQ, plans to travel to several different locations this year and operate using his Elecraft K3/100. His expected schedule for the year is:
 May 23-28th - Dodecanese (EU-001, GIOTA DKS-006, MIA MGD-028, WLOTA 0045); callsign SV5/N6GQ; plans to be in the CQWW WPX CW Contest (May 26-27th) as a SOAB QRP entry. QSL via LoTW or N6GQ.
 May 28th-June 17th - Greece; callsign SV8/N6GQ; plans to be active from various IOTAs (EU-049 and EU-052) in SV8. QSL via LoTW or N6GQ.
 June 17-29th - Malta (EU-023, MIA MM-001, WLOTA 1113); callsign 9H3ZZ. QSL via LoTW or N6GQ.
- **HH, HAITI** ~ Tiho, 9A7GAE, is on a Red Cross mission in Léogâne, and is expected to receive his Haitian license by the time you read this. He will be active as HH2/9A7GAE on 80/40/20/17/10/6 meters using as CP6 antenna. Activity will be limited to his free time (this is not a DX- pedition). He will operate on SSB and later on the Digital modes. His equipment arrived from the USA, but now he has a problem of finding any tower sections, cables, connectors...etc. (there is nothing available in Leogane). QSL card via his home callsign (LoTW later).
- **IOTA NEWS ~ AS-147.** Yuki, JO2ASQ, will be active as JO2ASQ/8 from both Rishiri and Rebus Islands between April 30th and May 3rd. Look for updates on his Twitter page [in Japanese] at: <https://twitter.com/#!/JO2ASQ> **EU-043.** Operators Ric/DL2VFR and Norbert/DL2RNS will be active as SD7V/6 and SD7N/6, respectively, from Orust Island between May 11-14th. Activity will be on the HF bands using CW and SSB, with high power. QSL via their home callsigns, by the Bureau or direct. **EU-061.** Operators Ric/DL2VFR and Norbert/DL2RNS will be active as LA/homecall from the Hvaler Islands between May 16-21st. Activity will be on the HF bands, using CW and SSB, with high power. QSL via their home callsigns, direct or by the Bureau.
- **KH3, JOHNSTON ATOLL (Op Cancelled!)** ~ It was reported this past week that Susan, W7KFI, has officially given up on KH3. This will be a big disappointment to many who have been waiting for her to be on the air.
- **KP2, U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS** ~ Yuriy, N2TTA, will be active as KP2MM during the CQWW WPX CW Contest (May 26-27th) as a Single-Op/All-Band/Low-Power entry. QSL via LoTW. For more details, see: <http://www.n2tta.info>
- **V2, ANTIGUA** ~ Darrell, AB2E, will once again be active as V26E from Antigua (NA-100) between May 23-30th. Activity will include the CQWW WPX CW Contest (May 26-27th) as Single-Op/All-Band/Low-Power (A) entry -- same as last year which resulted in #2 World and #1 North America for the category. All operations before and after the contests will be either on the 30/17/12 meter bands or the lower bands. Also, for the first time he will attempt RTTY on all bands. QSL direct via AB2E for any and all operations from 1993 to present. Be sure to include an SASE, green stamp, or new IRC, or you won't get a card. Sorry, no Bureau cards at this time, and no eQSL. As of February 28, 2011, all logs from all V26E operations (including 2010) have been uploaded to LoTW as well.
- **V3, BELIZE** ~ Mike, VE2XB, will once again be active as V31XB from Caye Caulker Island (NA-073) between May 11-31st. Activity will be on all HF bands, as well as 6m, using CW and SSB.
