

- There were not minutes from December since that meeting was replaced with our annual Christmas banquet.
- Membership report was given by Carl W8KRF. Currently in the process of renewals.
- Website report was also given by Carl W8KRF. This is the clubs main means of disseminating announcements about events and activities. Please check it often.

- Education committee report given by Alex N8QL. We are planning another class in the spring if enough people are interested. There is an interest in an Extra class but we would need experienced teachers to properly administer this class. It is still a possibility.
- During the Repeater committee report, Carl W8KRF gave a short briefing on the new Yaesu System Fusion repeaters which the club will be receiving in late February at a much reduced cost. There were some concerns but mostly acceptance of this system which will accommodate both digital (C4FM) and analog FM users. There will be extensive testing of the system before it is placed in service at the Elyria site. A motion was made and passed to allocate \$800 towards the purchase and installation of the first system. Approval for the purchase/reimbursement of the second repeater will be sought at a future meeting.
- Dave W8KFJ gave a short synopsis of what his program will consist of in February. He has asked that those interested in SDRs access a SDR 101 Primer which has links on our website on the Education page. If you plan to attend the February meeting, please download and read this primer so you will able to better understand his more advanced presentation. SRDs are here and already inside many radios. Learn more about them and the future of ham radio.





## **Commission Terms**
