March 2015 Meeting Minutes

- Meeting called to order by President Clark Beckman N8PZD at 7:00PM
- Tom W8KYZ lead the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Tom read the Treasurer's Report. It was moved and passed to accept the report
- A motion to accept the February meeting minutes was made and passed to accept the minutes as published in the newsletter.
- Committee reports were given:
 - Education: Alex reported a General Class license class is scheduled to begin on April 1st if a minimum of 5 students enroll. At the time of the meeting only 2 were registered.
 - Newsletter: W8KRF requesting input.
 - Website: W8KRF reports it is up-to-date. Please check the website regularly to keep up with any announcements.
 - Repeater: The new System Fusion repeater was on display. Because it is interfaced with the CAT-1000B controller it's true functionality will not be experienced. As it stands today, it will permit two modes of operation: Analog FM in, Analog FM out; Digital C4FM in, Digital C4FM out. It is not capable of cross mode operation with an external controller at this time. Future firmware updates from Yaesu may change this limitation.
 - A motion was made by W8KRF to reimburse him for the second DR-IX which will be delivered in April. The motion passed.
- The business meeting was adjourned at/or around 7:30PM.

The program for the evening was presented by Eric, N8AUC, the District Emergency Coordinator for Ohio District 10. The topic was Digital Emergency Communications. Eric and his assistant, Carl, KB8VXE demonstrated the use of a digital program called Fldigi and associated add-ons to pass emergency communications. The program was very interesting and informative. It is hoped that members will download this program, which is free and well supported, and practice using it.

APRIL PRESENTATION: SDR FOLO – Watching SDR do its tricks!

Chet Roberts (K8KIZ) will be bringing in his Elad FDM-S2 SDR Receiver along with his Kenwood TS-2000 transceiver. The demonstration will explain the unique features an SDR radio offers, as well as how an SDR to can be coupled to another rig. You'll experience 'live' tuning of several signal types to see the SDR in action.

Chet says the SDR/rig combo offers the best of all possible worlds: the hi-tech capability of SDR including its waterfall displays and incredibly variable width filters for razor sharp reception, plus the ability to link to his TS-2000's 100 watt transmitter eliminating the need for an additional rf amplifier and power supply.



Commission Terms

ARRL Affiliated Clubs receive a commission for every new ARRL membership they submit to ARRL Headquarters.

Clubs retain **\$15 for each new membership** OR lapsed membership (of two years or more). A NEW MEMBER is defined as any individual who has never been a member of ARRL or any individual who has not retained a membership for two or more calendar years prior to the application submission.

If you are <u>not</u> an ARRL member, <u>please</u> consider joining now. As an affiliated Club, we are required that 51% of our membership be active ARRL members.
