Since delivery, I have pretty much spent all my time assembling and testing the DR-IX which had to be interfaced with our CAT-1000B controller and a ULI for EchoLink. I decided to move EchoLink to the repeater site instead of linking it from my house using my personal D710AG transceiver. Ron from CAT Controllers was very much involved in my accomplishment of this task. May Meeting Program

With Field Day rapidly approaching, we will discuss details and determine who will provide equipment and how many bands we will operate. If you have not participated in a Field Day in the past and you plan to join us for this year's event, please attend this meeting.

The new Yaesu Fusion Repeater will be operational by the May meeting. There will be a few operational differences from the current analog repeater system. Hopefully, you will have used the new system and may have questions or comments. We will listen to any constructive criticism and attempt to remedy any problems you may have encountered. This is a new venture for NOARS since the "old" system has been in use for decades.

146.700, as well as a standalone DR-IX on 444.800.

To access both repeaters, you must have PL turned on. On 146.700 it is 110.9 and on 444.800 it is 131.8. If you turn CTCSS on your receive, you will not hear the digital "noise" nor will you hear any of the announcements, etc. We will experiment with the capability of both Analog FM and C4FM Digital. FM in, FM out; C4FM Digital in, C4FM Digital out.

We will also finally have a link to 145.150. This will be in Analog FM mode only. Users will be able to turn this link on and off by entering a DTMF sequence. To turn the link on, key up and enter 756; to turn it off, enter 757. As for EchoLink, in order to access other nodes, you must first press the "#" key followed by the node ID numbers. There are other options which we will discuss at our next meeting on May 18th.

There are several members who now have Yaesu System Fusion radios (FTM-400DR, FTIDR) so we encourage using the digital modes when the repeater is not in use by FM users. In addition to digital voice, we can send digital data in the form of pictures or messages.

Once Yaesu releases their next version of firmware for the DR-IX, we will be able interface a WiRES-X interface to the repeater and have world-wide communication capabilities. This is a new and exciting leap forward for NOARS. We will have one of the first fully functioning Yaesu System Fusion repeaters in Northern Ohio.

Commission Terms

ARRL Affiliated Clubs receive a commission for every new ARRL membership they submit to ARRL Headquarters.

Clubs retain \$15 for each new membership OR lapsed membership (of two years or more). A NEW MEMBER is defined as any individual who has never been a member of ARRL or any individual who has not retained a membership for two or more calendar years prior to the application submission.

If you are <u>not</u> an ARRL member, <u>please</u> consider joining now. As an affiliated Club, we are required that 51% of our membership be active ARRL members. If you are joining, contact Tom Porter, W8KYZ. **This is important**.
