How long have you been a

Since I passed my tech license in November 2014 with the Help of a class conducted by NOARS members.

What/who got you interested in amateur radio?

I have been interested in amateur radio since I was a teenager and listened to it on just a receiver. I've never had the time or the money to get back into it until recently. I thought it would be something to do, especially in the winter months when I could not go out and shoot.

What modes of operation do you like best? (VOIP, digital, repeaters, CW, etc.)

I'm not sure yet, I've only done FM and are just getting started in to digital and SSB

Awards, activities, nets:

I try to get on the I0m and 2m nets, as often as I can. And of course the Russ and Johnny show. I have joined LCRA and ARES, but I need to get more involved and get on their nets.

Current projects?

Learning to use my Kenwood 2000 and my brand-new Yaseu FTM-1000DR.

Also I am building a 40 m inverted V antenna and will probably make it a 40/80 after I learn to wind large coils. I just finished putting up a rotor and SSB antennas for 2m and 70cm bands

What would you like to learn more about?

Everything, and especially enough to pass my general license exam, after that I want to get more into digital & SSB.

What line of work were/are you in?

I was an educator, first a teacher in public school (science), then a teacher(adult basic education) in the adult prison system at London Ohio correctional institution, then I became school administrator, and then I became principal of a region which included usually three or four institutions up north including at various times, Mansfield, Lorain, Grafton, Lake Erie, Trumbull, Belmont, and the Ohio State penitentiary.

I believe that much of the enjoyment comes from the friendliness and willingness to help you of established amateur radio operators. Without this I don't think very many people would be into amateur radio.



ARRL Affiliated Clubs receive a commission for every new ARRL membership they submit to ARRL Headquarters.

Clubs retain \$15 for each new membership OR lapsed membership (of two years or more). A NEW MEMBER is defined as any individual who has never been a member of ARRL or any individual who has not retained a membership for two or more calendar years prior to the application submission.
