## Past Program: January 18th

NOARS member Bill Adams WD8OSJ holds a General Class license and hails from Sheffield Lake. He has been a ham and a tinkerer since 1970.

Not to be confused with spider beam or hex antennas, Bill described different construction methods of "cobweb" or "spider web" antennas.

This multiband, compact, HF aerial is relatively easy and inexpensive to build. One example of folded-dipole construction consists primarily of

PVC pipe, a connection box, concentrically strung speaker wire, and a six-turn RG-58 balun. Five bands would take up minimal area, with the maximum spread only around 16 feet.

Having an omnidirectional radiation pattern, the cobweb antenna does not need much height to be effective. In fact, Bill said his SWR readings remained fairly constant whether the antenna was close to the ground or merely up 20 feet.


