software. I needed to start with a new clean image and reconfigure from scratch. The only issue I had was the inability to transmit when a node was connected. After some digging and going back and forth to the site, I found it was an advanced config setting that needed to be edited manually for CTCSS. Once that was done, I was also able to adjust the audio level going out to the connected nodes.

I found that there are parrot nodes that repeat back your transmission and will tell you the audio quality for adjustment. I hear things are sounding much better on the connected Allstar nets now.

The cheapest is Akamai cloud, about \$5 a month.




